



# RCM CURRICULUM

## Offered at Harmony Music Academy

The Royal Conservatory of Music is an internationally recognized curriculum that focuses on developing and advancing technical skills and repertoire. This regulated curriculum offers up to 12 levels of graduating difficulty and is tested by certified examiners who undergo extensive continuous training to maintain a consistent standard of grading. In addition to maintaining consistent performance progression, the Royal Conservatory of Music curriculum will help develop time management skills, self-discipline, motivation, and personal growth!

## FAQ'S

### WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Students may be recommended by their instructor based on performance, consistency, and discipline. A private consultation is required prior to registration.

### HOW DOES IT WORK?

Each student will work carefully and consistently with their instructor to prepare for the annual Springtime exam. Practical exams require demonstration of technical skills, repertoire performance, ear training, and sight-reading skills. Exams are graded on a scale of 0 -100, with 60+ being passing. Upon passing an exam, a certificate is awarded to show completion. Testing is offered at designated locations, the closest of which is at Moore's School of Music at University of Houston Downtown campus.

### WHAT DOES IT COST?

The full annual cost for 48 weeks is \$1880 including materials. RCM students must commit to the full year rather than semester by semester. Payment plans are offered.
